The LOFT Presents *La Ventana al Alma: Works by K. L. Campbell*
Reception Scheduled for Sunday, May 6, 2007

(White Plains, NY) March 22, 2007 – The LOFT today announced the reception of an upcoming art exhibit, entitled *La Ventana al Alma (The Window to the Soul): Works by K. L. Campbell*, which will be held on Sunday, May 6, from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., at the gallery at The LOFT in White Plains, NY. The solo exhibit will be on display May 1-31.

The month-long art exhibit will feature paintings and sculpture by Campbell, exhibited together for the first time. Select works will be for sale, and a portion of the proceeds will be donated to The LOFT – The Lesbian and Gay Community Services Center, which serves New York's Lower Hudson Valley.

About the work being shown, Campbell said, "I am fascinated by the diversity of cultures that comprise our global society. And the exploration of LGBT issues (lesbian, gay, bi-sexual and transgender) has made its way into my work. With the biased media coverage of gay pride and marriage, increase in hate crime, and general intolerance of many when it comes to LGBT subject matter, I feel strongly that creating art which attempts to aid people in confronting their fear or misconceptions of homosexuality is vitally important."

The reception on May 6 is free to the public, and a brief interview with K. L. Campbell will be broadcast live from The LOFT at 2:00 p.m. on WVOX 1460 AM and will be streaming live on the web at www.wvox.com.
